Routines: Routines create structure in both the parents and child’s day. Routines are explored and discussed by reviewing examples of common routines in the morning and after school, at mealtimes and at bedtime. Discussion includes how to set a child up for success and keep the family on track.

Speech & Language: This workshop is facilitated by the Toronto Preschool Speech and Language. Parents and caregivers will learn to identify developmental milestones in speech and language as well as ways to recognize delays. You will be taught strategies to help improve your child’s ability to interact with their peers and their overall communication development.

Growth & Development Parents and caregivers will learn more about realistic expectations related to children’s development and milestones.
